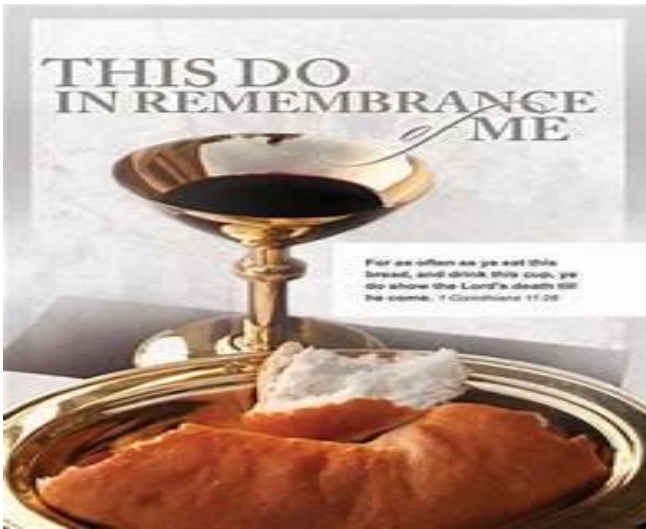

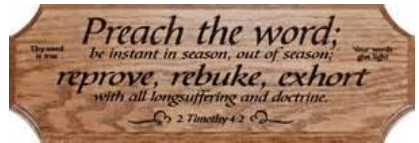
“A Christian’s Position in A Sinful World”

Church Covenant

Having been led, as we believe, by the spirit of God, to receive the Lord Jesus Christ as our Savior. The Lord's Supper
I Corinthians 11: 23-26)

Minister: The Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said,

Congregation: Take eat; this is My body which is broken for you; this do **in remembrance of Me.**

Minister: In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, this cup is the new covenant in My blood.

Congregation: This do, as often as you drink it, **in remembrance of Me.**

Minister: For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, **you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes."**

Congregation: This is the Word of God

Minister: Bless be the name of the Lord.
